Return to Sea and Sardinia

The Film and The Photobook

The film documentary Return to Sea and Sardinia (2021) co-produced by **The Visual Guys** and **Daniele Marzeddu**, follows in the footsteps of the journey made by D.H. Lawrence in 1921 from Sicily to Sardinia, as described in his travel book Sea and Sardinia (1921).

The international crew composed of **Daniele Marzeddu** (director and creator of the project), **Vicki L. Baker** (Director Assistant and stage photographer), **Antonio Meloni** (sound engineer, editor and visual effects), **Whitelabrecs** (Soundtrack Production & Audio Mastering), completed the journey across the two islands of the Mediterranean: from Cagliari to Mandas, then Sorgono, Tonara, Gavoi, Nuoro, Orosei, Siniscola, Olbia, and from Taormina to Palermo, sailing to Cagliari.

Director's Notes

Sea and Sardinia is a travelogue by the English writer D. H. Lawrence which describes a short excursion undertaken in January 1921 by Lawrence and his wife Frieda from Taormina, Sicily, to Sardinia. Despite the shortness of the trip, Lawrence distils an essence of the island and its people still recognizable today. Excerpts were originally printed in The Dial magazine in October and November 1921, while the book was published in December of that year by New York-based publisher Thomas Seltzer, featuring illustrations by painter Jan Juta.

Synopsis

When D.H. Lawrence decided to take a trip to Sardinia in 1921, he certainly would not have imagined the cultural significance of the book that followed from his journey - Sea and Sardinia. With the support of the DH Lawrence Society of Great Britain and the literary consultancy offered by Nick Ceramella, vice president of the Society, Return to Sea and Sardinia follows in the footsteps of Lawrence's journey one hundred years later, with vivid images of the photographer-director Daniele Marzeddu. The film retraces, step by step, the path of the English writer in contemporary key. Return to Sea and Sardinia will be accompanied by a limited-edition photographic book, equipped with a visual / iconography of Lawrencian places of yesterday and today.
